Structure is a project and portfolio management tool that helps users visualize, track and manage progress across Jira projects and teams. It does this with adaptable, user-defined, issue hierarchies presented in a familiar spreadsheet-like view of Jira issues.

Structure has a number of powerful features:

- Multiple, shareable structures
- Unlimited hierarchies
- Customizable views
- Totals, aggregate calculations
- Powerful user interface with keyboard shortcuts
- On-the-spot issue creation and editing
